TO ENTER YOUR ROSES YOU MUST REGISTER BY AUG 25
HOW TO REGISTER

In order to enter your roses at The Fair, you must register by August 25. (For questions regarding online entry registration, contact: 253-841-5074, CompExhibits@thefair.com.) If you do not have access to a computer, you can arrive at the Fair gate with your roses and register when you enter the Floral Building.

To register online, go to theFair.com. From the main headings, Participate, enter a Competition, WA state Fair Entry Information & Competition Guides, Floral.

*Go down the list and choose 'Floral'. Then go down to page 4 which has the Registration Instructions. Choose **ONLINE ENTRY REGISTRATION - Choose Register***

*I am a - Choose a type - **Exhibitor***

First and last name

*Choose **I am a new exhibitor or have yet to register this year**. Continue*

Enter your password from before or create a password. Continue

Fill in the rest of the needed information.

Continue and confirm the information you have entered. Continue

*Department - choose a department - **Floral Show***

*Choose a Division - **Floral Pre-registration, Div 554***

*Select Class: **Class 001 Pre-registratration***

Add entry to cart

Checkout

*Fill in YES to the "I agree" statement and **Submit***

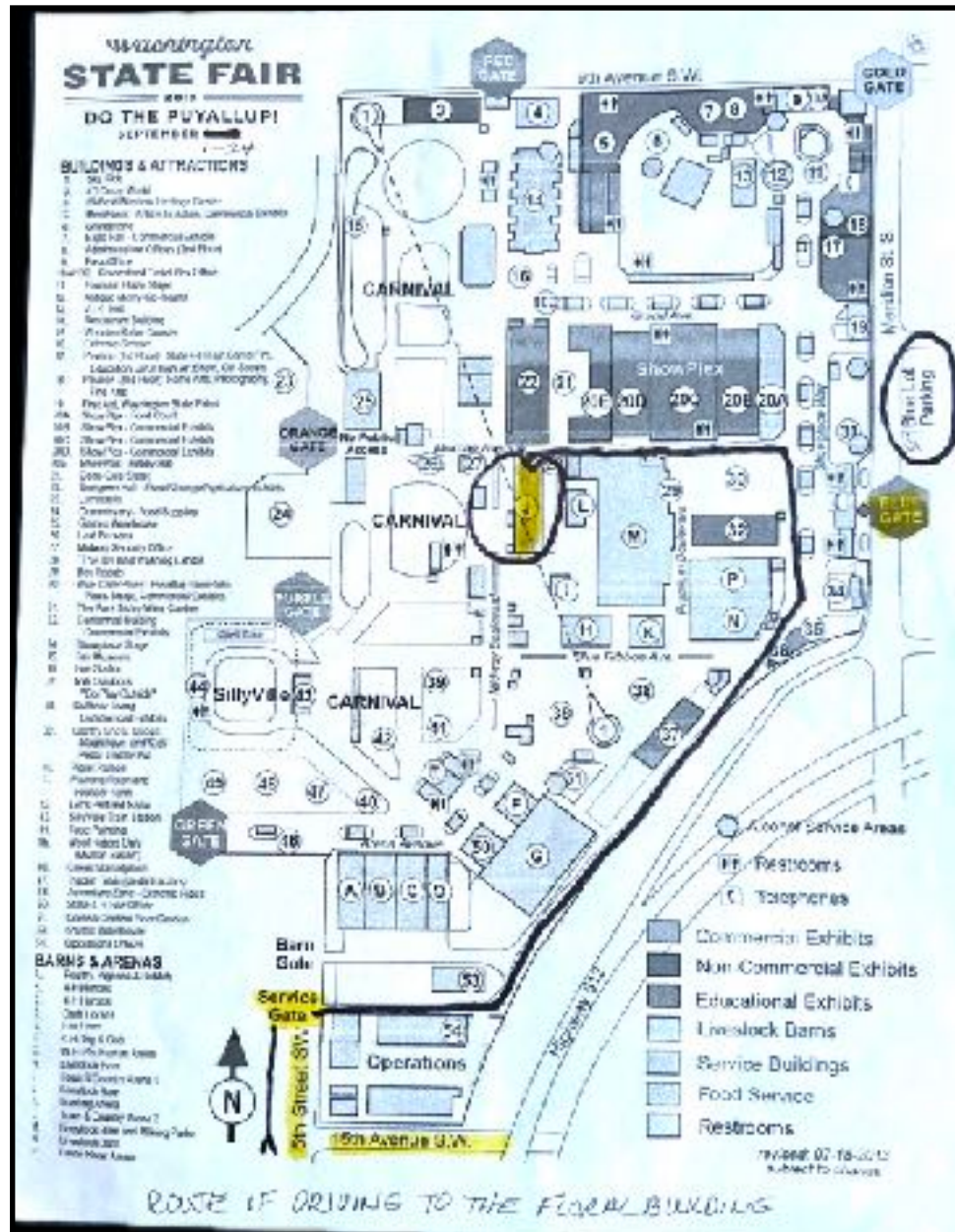
Print detailed report. Also email a copy of my receipt to your email address

It is important to have the printed registration.** You may be asked to show it when you arrive at the Fair with your roses. **If you are an exhibitor, entry to the Fair is free!

Then print pages 16-18 (the show schedule) and take them along with your printed registration form to the Fair.

***Entries are accepted from 6am to 8:45am.** When you arrive at the Floral Building, you need to check in at the desk near the entrance. There you will show your registration information, get an **exhibitor number** and entry tags. The entry tags are two pages. Enter your exhibitor number, the Division number (Aug 31 is 533, Sept 7 is 534, Sept 14 is 535), class # and variety depends on the rose you are entering. (If you are a novice the Division numbers are (Aug31is 539, Sept 7 is 540 Sept 14 is 541). A novice is a *person* who has won ten or fewer blue ribbons). Exhibitor's name - we usually use small mailing address labels on both pages but you can enter your name here. Before putting the entry tag on the vase (provided), tear off the first page. Fold the second page so it covers your name and use a paper clip (provided) to close it. Put your roses that are ready to enter at the front of your table and someone will put your roses in the correct spot. When you have entered all your roses, gather up the pile of "first pages" and put them in order by class number. Paper clip them together and hand them to the person at the front desk.*

Map with the Floral Building J circled in black. If walking in, enter at the Blue Gate. Directions for driving to the Floral Building in black. Use the Service Gate.

If you have lots of roses and would prefer to drive onto the Fairgrounds this is how you can do that. The Service Gate is located on 5th ST SW off 15th Ave SW - . You can drop off your roses at the Floral Building (J) and then leave the fairgrounds and park in one of the parking lots. **Be sure to get your hand stamped for re-entry before driving out of the fairgrounds. Please note that all vehicles must be off the Fairgrounds by 8:45am.** You can show your registration form at the gate for free entry.
